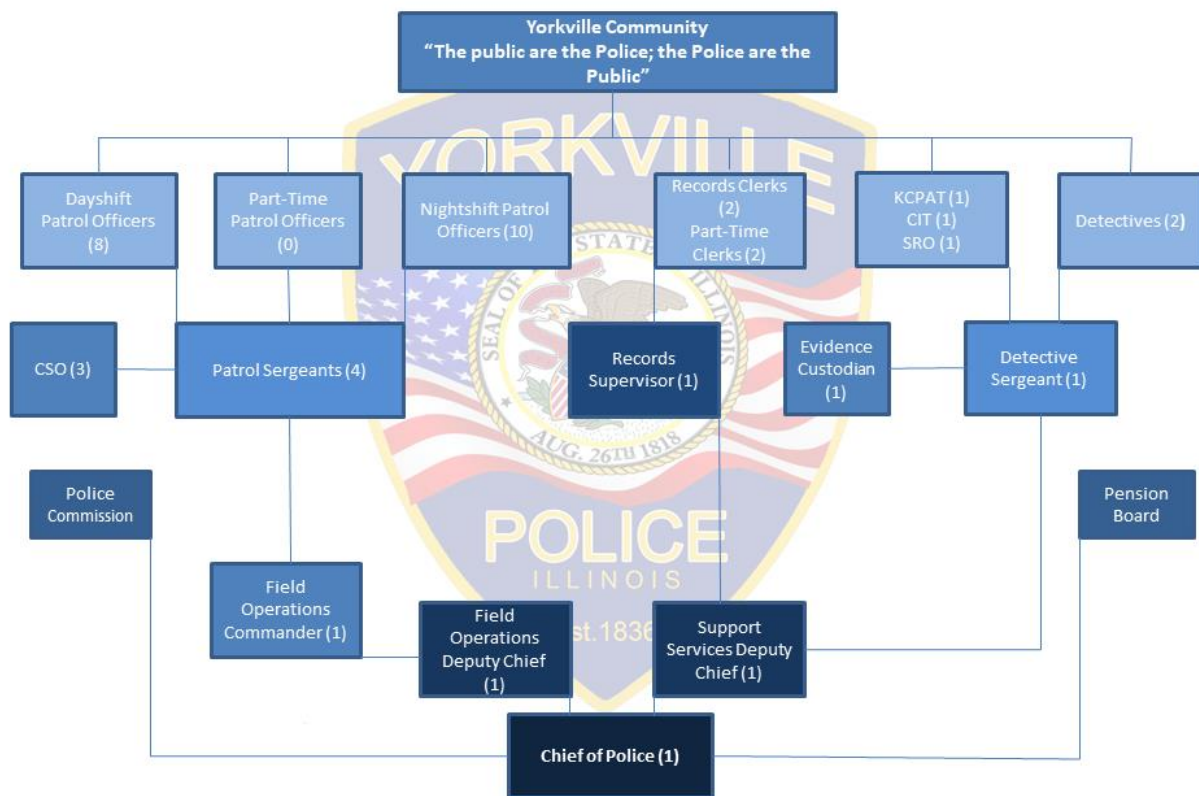

DETECTIVE SQUAD

On 04/05/2023 Jerrold J. Rapcan was taken into custody by the Yorkville Police Department after the Investigation Division obtained an arrest warrant for Rapcan's arrest. The warrant was issued after the completion of an investigation regarding an incident that occurred on 03/26/2023 in the 500 block of Walsh Court. Rapcan was charged with 21 felony counts of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault, Criminal Sexual Assault, and Criminal Sexual Abuse.

On 04/14/2023, the Yorkville Police Department was made aware of a report of an alleged criminal sexual assault involving family doctor Edgar E. Archbold. It was learned that Archbold had allegedly sexually assaulted an employee, who was also a patient of Archbold, between July of 2022 and April of 2023. Through the investigation, it was learned that these allegations occurred primarily at his office located at the 500 Block of E. Kendall Drive. On 04/17/2023 Archbold was taken into custody and subsequently charged with 11 counts of Criminal Sexual Assault and Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse.

On 04/25/2023, the Yorkville Police Department responded to the 1400 Block of Orchid Street for a report of a Home Invasion. The Investigation Division responded to assist, and it was later learned that a suspect had been taken into custody in another jurisdiction. That suspect was subsequently charged with Home Invasion and Robbery. This investigation remains open and active.

During the month of April, the Investigations Division assisted with moving from the old facility at 804 Game Farm Road to the new facility located at 651 Prairie Pointe Drive. This included assisting with the move of the vault, which contains approximately 7,800 items of evidence. Prior

to and after the move, Commander McMahon and Detective Sergeant Nelson completed an audit of the vault to ensure no items were lost during the transfer.
