### **VERIFIED OBJECTOR'S PETITION**

NOW COMES Sammy Hall, hereinafter referred to as the "Objector," and respectfully represents that Objector resides at 1567 Coral Drive, Yorkville, IL 60560, in the 4th Ward of the City of Yorkville, State of Illinois; that Objector is a duly qualified, registered, and legal voter at said address; that Objector's interest in filing the following objections is that of a citizen desirous of ensuring that the laws governing the filing of nomination papers for Alderperson of Ward 4 of the City of Yorkville in the State of Illinois are properly complied with and that only qualified candidates have their names appear on the ballot as candidates for the said office. Therefore, your Objector makes the following objections to the nomination papers of Lowell Hyett as a candidate for election to the office of Alderperson of Ward 4 of the City of Yorkville, State of Illinois, and files the same herewith, and states that the said nomination papers are insufficient in law and in fact for the following reasons:

### 1. Failure to Accurately Identify the Office Being Sought

The nomination papers submitted by the Candidate inaccurately list the office being sought as "Alderman of the 4th Ward." The Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/10-4) explicitly requires that nomination petitions include a uniform and accurate heading identifying the office being sought. "Alderman" is not a legally recognized office title for this election, as the correct and inclusive title is "Alderperson." This fundamental defect misrepresents the office and undermines the integrity of the petition.

### Case Law:

Wiesner v. Brennan: Establishes that failing to accurately name the office being sought
is a fatal defect that invalidates nomination petitions. Misrepresentation misleads
voters and compromises the integrity of the electoral process.

### 2. Misleading Representation to Petition Signers

By failing to accurately identify the office title, the Candidate's petition misleads potential signers. If a signer sought to research the office of "Alderman," they would find no such position on official documents or election materials. This misrepresentation deprives signers of their ability to make an informed decision, thereby invalidating the petition.

### 3. Violation of Inclusivity Standards

The use of the outdated term "Alderman" contradicts the intentional name change to "Alderperson," which reflects Yorkville's commitment to inclusivity and equity. This error could discourage individuals who do not identify as male from aspiring to participate in the electoral process, contrary to the purpose of the title change.

### 4. Invalidity of Signatures

The Candidate's failure to properly identify the office in the petition renders the signatures collected invalid. The omission of an accurate title prevents signers from legally supporting the Candidate for a recognized office, thereby invalidating the entire nomination petition.

### 5. Signature Threshold Miscalculation

Mr. Hyett's candidacy also fails to meet the proper legal requirements for the signature threshold:

- Wrong Election Year Used: The Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/10-3.1) mandates that
  the signature requirement must be based on the most recent election for the specific
  office being sought. The correct election year for the specific Ward 4 seat is 2021, during
  which 158 total votes were cast. Using this figure, the required number of signatures is
  no less than 8 signatures (5%).
- Inflated Voter Count for 2023: Even if the 2023 election data were relevant—which it is not—Mr. Hyett incorrectly calculated the signature threshold using 603 votes, as stated in his objection against me. Research and verified evidence from the Kendall County's official Integra Election Reporting Console and the official KendallCountyIL.gov website confirm that the actual number of votes cast in the 2023 election for Ward 4 was 556 votes, not 603.

### • Violation of Election Code and Case Law Precedent:

- Corbin v. Schroeder: The Illinois Supreme Court invalidated petitions due to reliance on incorrect election data, emphasizing the importance of strict adherence to statutory requirements.
- Pilz v. McHenry County Electoral Board: Reinforces that reliance on incorrect or inflated data invalidates petitions.
- Tully v. Edgar: Confirms the necessity of adhering to statutory requirements to ensure electoral fairness.

### 6. Objection to His Challenge Against My Petition

Mr. Hyett's objection to my petition should be dismissed because he was never a valid candidate for this office. His entire nomination petition is invalid due to the improper naming of the office, the inflated voter count from 2023, and reliance on the wrong election year. Without standing as a valid candidate, he has no legal basis to challenge another candidate's petition.

### **Relief Sought**

Your Objector respectfully requests that the Municipal Officers Electoral Board:

- 1. Immediately invalidate the nomination papers of Lowell Hyett in their entirety for failing to comply with the Illinois Election Code and misleading potential petition signers.
- 2. Dismiss any objection filed by Lowell Hyett against the Objector's nomination papers on the grounds that the Candidate is not a valid candidate for the office of Alderperson and therefore lacks standing to object.

### WHEREFORE,

Your Objector prays that the purported nomination papers of Lowell Hyett for election to the office of Alderperson of Ward 4 of the City of Yorkville in the State of Illinois be declared by this Honorable Electoral Board to be insufficient and not in compliance with the laws of the State of Illinois and that the Candidate's name be stricken and that this Honorable Electoral Board enter its decision declaring that the name of Lowell Hyett for election to the office of Alderperson of the City of Yorkville in the State of Illinois **NOT BE PRINTED** on the OFFICIAL BALLOT for the Consolidated Election to be held on April 1, 2025.

It is the opinion of the City Attorney that a proper form and petition for independent candidates is the "Independent Candidates Petition - P-3, Revised March 2020". If not filing as an independent candidate, the 2025 Candidate's Guide issued by the Illinois State Board of Elections should be followed. Quoting from the preface in the 2025 Candidates Guide: "Legal information contained in this guide, is not binding and should not be construed as legal advice or sufficient argument in response to an objection to any candidate's nominating papers. The State Board of Elections recommends that all prospective candidates consult with competent legal counsel when preparing their nomination papers."

Filing of Nominating Petitions

Nominating petitions should be completed, signed, and notarized, as required, prior to filing with the Office of the City Clerk. Please be aware that city notary services are only available Monday - Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Persons requiring notary services from the city on the first day of filing will not be considered to have filed at 8:00 a.m. for the purpose of a lottery to consider first placement on the ballot because the petition of nomination is not complete until notarized.

### **Signature Counts**

Per the State of Illinois Candidates Guide 2025, issued by the State Board of Elections, regarding Number of Signatures required for Independent Candidates:

"For the consolidated election, not less than 5% nor more than 8% (or 50 more than the minimum, whichever is greater) of the number of persons who voted at the last regular election in the district or political subdivision in which the district or political subdivision voted as a unit for the election of officers to serve its respective territorial area. (10 ILCS 5/10-3"

NOTE: In municipalities with a population over 5,000, candidates of established political parties file petitions to be placed on the consolidated primary election ballot.

Municipalities: Municipalities of <u>5,000 or less</u> population may determine by ordinance, no later than November <u>15</u>, 2024, that political parties shall nominate candidates for municipal offices by primary election in accordance with Articl 7 of the Election Code. (<u>10 ILCS 5/7-1(b)</u>)

Cities: Cities of 10,000 or fewer inhabitants may, by ordinance, allow for the appointment of a city treasurer. (65 ILCS 5/3.1-15-5)

Villages of fewer than 5,000 inhabitants may, by resolution, choose to have the clerk appointed by the village president with the concurrence of the village board. (65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-90(a))

This procedure for the election of officers includes municipalities that have adopted the managerial form and retained or later adopted the mayor-alderperson or president-trustee form of electing their officers. (65 ILCS 5/5-1-2)

Qualified elector of the municipality and one-year residency in the municipality preceding the election. (65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(a))

Alderpersons must reside in the ward at least one year prior to their election. Trustees elected from districts must resid in their municipality at least one year prior to their election. For trustees elected <u>by district</u> in villages with a population of over 5,000, each of the districts shall be represented by one trustee who shall have been a resident of the district for at least six months immediately before their election in the first election after redistricting.

(65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(c), 3.1-25-75(a)(b))

If a person is a resident of a municipality immediately prior to the active duty military service of that person or that person's spouse, resides anywhere outside of the municipality during that active duty military service, and immediately upon completion of that active duty military service is again a resident of the municipality, then the time during which

the person resides outside the municipality during the active duty military service is deemed to be time during which the person is a resident of the municipality for purposes of determining the residency requirement. (65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-5(d))

A person is not eligible to take the oath of office for a municipal office if that person is, at the time required for taking the oath of office, in arrears in the payment of a tax or other indebtedness due to the municipality or has been convicte in any court located in the United States of any infamous crime, bribery, perjury, or other felony. A person convicted of a felony, bribery, perjury, or other infamous crime, for an offense committed on or after November 17, 2023 (the effective date of Public Act 103-562) and committed while the person was serving as a public official in this State, is ineligible to hold any local public office unless the person's conviction is reversed, the person is again restored to such rights by the terms of a pardon for the offense, the person has received a restoration of rights by

Such petition shall be signed by qualified primary electors residing in the political division for which the nomination is sought in their own proper persons only and opposite the signature of each signer, his residence address shall be written or printed. The residence address required to be written or printed opposite each qualified primary elector's name shall include the street address or rural route number of the signer, as the case may be, as well as the signer's county, and city, village or town, and state. However, the county or city, village or town, and state of residence of the electors may be printed on the petition forms where all of the electors signing the petition reside in the same county or city, village or town, and state. Standard abbreviations may be used in writing the residence address, including street number, if any. At the bottom of

All petition sheets which are filed with the proper local election officials, election authorities or the State Board of Elections shall be the original sheets which have been signed by the voters and by the circulator thereof, and not photocopies or duplicates of such sheets. Each petition must include as a part thereof, a statement of candidacy for each of the candidates filing, or in whose behalf the petition is filed. The petitions, when filed, shall not be withdrawn or added to, and no signatures shall be revoked except by revocation filed in writing with the State Board of Elections, election authority or local election official with whom the petition is required to be filed, and before the filing of such petition. In the first primary election following a redistricting of congressional districts, a candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least 600 signatures of qualified primary electors of the candidate's political party in his or her congressional district.(c) County office. Except as otherwise provided in this Code, if a candidate seeks to run for any countywide office, including, but not limited to, county board chairperson or county board member, elected on an at-large basis, in a county other than Cook County, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified electors of his or her party who cast votes at the last preceding general election in his or her county. If a candidate seeks to run for county board member elected from a county board district, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified primary electors

of his or her party in the county board district. In the first primary election following a redistricting of county board districts or the initial establishment of county board districts, a candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified electors of his or her party in the entire county who cast votes at the last preceding general election divided by the total number of county board districts comprising the county board; provided that in no event shall the number of signatures be less than 25.(d) County office; Cook County only.(1) If a candidate seeks to run for countywide office in Cook County, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified electors of his or her party who cast votes at the last preceding general election in Cook County. (2) If a candidate seeks to run for Cook County Board Commissioner, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified primary electors of his or her party in his or her county board district. In the first primary election following a redistricting of Cook County Board of Commissioners districts, a candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the qualified electors of his or her party in the entire county who cast votes at the last preceding general election divided by the total number of county board districts comprising the county board; provided that in no event shall the number of signatures be less than 25.(3) Except as otherwise provided in this Code, if a candidate seeks to run for Cook County Board of Review Commissioner, which is elected from a district pursuant to subsection (c) of Section 5-5 of the Property Tax Code, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the total number of registered voters in his or her board of review district in the last general election at which a commissioner was regularly scheduled to be elected from that board of review district. (g) Sanitary district trustee. Except as

otherwise provided in this Code, if a candidate seeks to run for trustee of a sanitary district in which trustees are not elected from wards, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the primary electors of his or her party from the sanitary district. If a candidate seeks to run for trustee of a sanitary district in which trustees are elected from wards, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the primary electors of his or her party in the ward of that sanitary district. In the first primary election following redistricting of sanitary districts elected from wards, a candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the signatures of 150 qualified primary electors of his or her ward of that sanitary district.(h) Judicial office. Except as otherwise provided in this Code, if a candidate seeks to run for judicial office in a district, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain the number of signatures equal to 0.4% of the number of votes cast in that district for the candidate for his or her political party for the office of Governor at the last general election at which a Governor was elected, but in no event less than 500 signatures. If a candidate seeks to run for judicial office in a circuit or subcircuit, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain the number of signatures equal to 0.25% of the number of votes cast for the judicial candidate of his or her political party who received the highest number of votes at the last general election at which a judicial officer from the same circuit or subcircuit was regularly scheduled to be elected, but in no event less than 1,000 signatures in circuits and subcircuits located in the First Judicial District or 500 signatures in every other Judicial District. (i) Precinct, ward, and township committeeperson. Except as otherwise provided in this Code, if a candidate seeks to run for precinct committeeperson, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least 10 signatures of the primary electors of his or her party for the precinct. If a candidate seeks to run for ward committeeperson, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain no less than the number of signatures equal to 10% of the primary electors of his or her party of the ward, but no more than 16% of those same electors; provided that the maximum number of signatures may be 50 more than the minimum number, whichever is greater. If a candidate seeks to run for township committeeperson, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain no less than the number of signatures equal to 5% of the primary electors of his or her party of the township, but no more than 8% of those same electors; provided that the maximum number of signatures may be 50 more than the minimum number, whichever is greater.(j) State's attorney or regional superintendent of schools for multiple counties. If a candidate seeks to run for State's attorney or regional Superintendent of Schools who serves more than one county, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the primary electors of his or her party in the territory comprising the counties. (k) Any other office. If a candidate seeks any other office, then the candidate's petition for nomination must contain at least the number of signatures equal to 0.5% of the registered voters of the political subdivision, district, or division for which the nomination is made or 25 signatures, whichever is greater. For purposes of this Section the number of primary electors shall be determined by taking the

For purposes of this Section the number of primary electors shall be determined by taking the total vote cast, in the applicable district, for the candidate for that political party who received the highest number of votes, statewide, at the last general election in the State at which electors for President of the United States were elected. For political subdivisions, the number of primary electors shall be determined by taking the total vote cast for the candidate for that

political party who received the highest number of votes in the political subdivision at the last regular election at which an officer was regularly scheduled to be elected from that subdivision. For wards or districts of political subdivisions, the number of primary electors shall be determined by taking the total vote cast for the candidate for that political party who received the highest number of votes in the ward or district at the last regular election at which an officer was regularly scheduled to be elected from that ward or district.

A "qualified primary elector" of a party may not sign petitions for or be a candidate in the primary of more than one party.

The changes made to this Section by Public Act 93-574 are declarative of existing law, except for item (3) of subsection (d).

Petitions of candidates for nomination for offices herein specified, to be filed with the same officer, may contain the names of 2 or more candidates of the same political party for the same or different offices. In the case of the offices of Governor and Lieutenant Governor, a joint petition including one candidate for each of those offices must be filed. 10 ILCS 5/7-10

Sec. 10-3.1. Petitions for nomination of nonpartisan candidates for offices to be filled at an election provided in Article 2A of this Code shall be in conformity with any requirements as to contents and number of signatures specified in the statute creating the political subdivision or providing the applicable form of government thereof. Petitions for nomination of nonpartisan candidates for municipal offices where the statute creating the municipality or providing the form of government thereof, or the ordinance so providing, pursuant to Article VII of the Constitution, requires election to such office on a nonpartisan basis and does not permit political party nominations (including without limitation Articles 4 and 5 of the Municipal Code) shall be in conformity with any requirements as to contents and number of signatures specified in such statute or ordinance.

The provisions of this Article 10 relating to independent candidate petition requirements shall apply to nonpartisan petitions to the extent they are not inconsistent with the requirements of such other statutes or ordinances.

If signature requirements for petitions for nomination of nonpartisan candidates are not specified in the statute creating the political subdivision or the signature requirements cannot be determined under Article 10, the signature requirements for the nonpartisan candidates shall be at least 0.5% of the total number of registered voters of the political subdivision for which the nomination is made or a minimum of 25, whichever is greater.

#### 1. Wiesner v. Brennan (2016 IL App (2d) 160115)

Issue: The candidate's nomination papers misidentified the office being sought.

Excerpt: "The failure to accurately name the office being sought is a fatal defect that invalidates nomination petitions."

#### Justia Law

Relevance: This case underscores the necessity of correctly identifying the office in nomination papers. Misnaming the office, as in your opponent's use of "Alderman" instead of "Alderperson," is a significant error that can invalidate the petition.

#### 2. Corbin v. Schroeder (2021 IL 127052)

*Issue:* The candidate relied on incorrect election data to meet signature requirements. *Excerpt:* "Reliance on incorrect election data fundamentally undermines the integrity of the nomination process and warrants invalidation of the petition."

#### Justia Law

*Relevance:* This case highlights the importance of using accurate and relevant election data when calculating signature thresholds. Your opponent's use of incorrect voter counts from the wrong election year mirrors the procedural errors identified in this case.

# 3. Pilz v. McHenry County Electoral Board (2015 IL App (2d) 150360)

*Issue:* The candidate failed to comply with statutory requirements in nomination papers. *Excerpt:* "Substantial compliance is insufficient when fundamental errors, such as misnaming the office, occur."

Relevance: This case reinforces that strict adherence to statutory requirements is mandatory. Misnaming the office and using incorrect data are fundamental errors that cannot be overlooked.

#### 4. Tully v. Edgar (171 III. 2d 297 (1996))

*Issue:* The necessity of adhering to procedural and statutory requirements in elections. *Excerpt:* "Ensuring that procedural and statutory requirements in elections are met is essential to maintain the integrity and fairness of the process."

*Relevance:* This case emphasizes the critical importance of following all procedural and statutory requirements to uphold the integrity of the electoral process.

# RULES OF PROCEDURE TO BE ADOPTED BY THE UNITED CITY OF YORKVILLE, KENDALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ELECTORAL BOARD FOR THE HEARING AND PASSING UPON OF OBJECTIONS TO THE NOMINATION PAPERS OF CANDIDATES

- 1. Appearance by an objector or by a candidate at the hearing on objections may be in person or by counsel. All parties appearing before the Board must file a completed Appearance form. On the Appearance form each party must provide the Board with telephone numbers and other contact information at which that party can be reached. These rules also apply to cases before the Board involving objections to referendum petitions, proponents and opponents to the petitions.
- 2. On the day set for the hearing of objections, both the objector and the candidate are required to be present in person or by counsel and to be ready for the initial hearing of their case.
- 3. The Board will grant no continuances or resetting of initial hearings on objections except for good cause shown. The Board may schedule proceedings in a case to extend beyond the initial day set for hearing.
- 4. If a candidate fails to appear for the hearing, a decision in the nature of a default judgment may be entered and the objections contained in the objector's petition shall be confessed against the candidate only upon a determination by the Board that the objector's petition sets forth valid grounds for the removal of the candidate's name from the ballot. If an objector fails to appear for the hearing, the Board may, in its sole discretion, default the objector and dismiss the objection. The Board has the sole discretion as to grant or deny a motion to withdraw an objection or objections. The Board may, in its sole discretion, require a preliminary showing of proof on the validity of any objection or may order a partial check of some portion of the allegations of an objection.
- 5. Preliminary motions and objections to an objector's petition in the nature of a motion to strike the objections may be heard first. If sufficient objections to an objector's petition are sustained, the objector's petition shall be overruled and the validity of the petitions held valid. If objections to a portion of an objector's petition are sustained, that part of the objector's petition shall be overruled.
- 6. The permanent registration records of the jurisdiction or jurisdictions involved shall be received as evidence with respect to all objections to which the material contained in such records is relevant. Relevant issues include, but are not limited to, whether the signer is a registered voter; whether the signer is a qualified elector, if required; whether the signature is that of a registered voter whose signature purports to appear on the petition; whether the signer or the candidate are residents of the City ward involved; and whether the signer is registered to vote at the address shown beside the signature on the petition in question. The Board may make appropriate provisions when an election authority has computerized its registration records, or otherwise created electronically-stored registration records.

When ordered by the Electoral Board, petitions and objections shall be compared with those registration records by the Office of the Kendall County Clerk's Election Department. The objector and the candidate each shall have the right to have designated and duly authorized representatives present at such comparison during their good conduct. The comparison shall commence at the time specified by the Electoral Board through its agent and the failure of the candidate, objector or their duly authorized representatives to timely appear for said comparison shall neither delay nor in any way affect the validity of the comparison. Notice to the parties will be given at the telephone numbers listed on their Appearance forms and notice may be given as late as 9:00 p.m. the evening before.

- 7. Representatives of the objector or candidate may object to the findings of the election authority's representative, which objection shall be noted by the election authority's representative. In no case shall a review of the result of the examination of an individual record or the presentation of additional evidence as to that record be permitted when no objection was made to the finding at the time of the comparison. It is the responsibility of the candidate or objector or their representatives to insure that any objection is recorded and preserved.
- 8. Within the parameters of the law, the Electoral Board will only consider written objections and the written specifications of such objections to the original petitions, as set forth in the objector's petition. The objector's petition may not be amended. No answer or response to the objector's petition need be filed.
- 9. All arguments of counsel and evidence must be confined to the points raised by the objections and specifications, if any, to the objector's petition, and by the objector's petition and specifications with respect to the nomination papers. The parties shall be limited to 15 minutes each for the presentation of their case, unless the Board extends the period of presentation.
- 10. If the objections to the nomination papers, or sufficient part thereof, are sustained, the nomination papers will be held invalid, and the Board will state its findings in a decision in writing, noting the objections which it has sustained. A decision may be executed by members of the Board in counterparts. If the objections, or a sufficient part thereof, are overruled, the nomination papers will be held valid, and the Board will state its findings in a written decision. In the event that the Board is sitting with only two members, and the two members do not agree as to the validity of any objection, that objection shall not be sustained.
- 11. After the Electoral Board convenes on the date and at the time set, it will be in session continuously until all objections have been considered and disposed of, and, if necessary, in the sole discretion of the Board, its session will be extended or recessed from time to time. One member of the Board may attend sessions by audio or video conferencing, when the other two members are physically present at the session.
