This year, we are offering three vehicle neighborhood parades for families to enjoy from their own front yard and ending the day with the spectacular fireworks show near Rt 47 and Countryside Pkwy at dusk. Due to the current State Guidelines, there will not be any organized activities at Town Square. PARADE INFORMATION

A vehicle parade will be organized in the southern, central and northern subdivisions, each starting at different times on the morning of July 4. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to decorate and enter a vehicle within the parade to show your American pride or to highlight your business! Participating floats do not need to confirm participation, simply arrive at the line-up location approximately 30 minutes before the parade is scheduled to begin. Please note, this is a vehicle-only parade, walkers will not be able to participate. Also, floats will not be allowed to throw candy or distribute any items from their vehicle and families are asked to follow all social distancing guidelines while viewing the parade.
