



The United City of Yorkville will be conducting a Partial Special Census to get an updated population count. This project is anticipated to start mid-May and go through July. Since the last U.S. Census in 2010, the City has seen substantial growth in new housing starts. The Mayor and City Council have come to the conclusion that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to officially document this increase in population. The major benefit is that it will enable Yorkville to receive an increased amount of state revenue. The City receives a portion of the state income tax, use tax, and motor fuel tax based on our population. Additional funding will help the City to continue to provide essential services and improve the quality of life for residents.

As it is partial, enumerators will only be contacting and surveying households in portions of the following subdivisions:

- Autumn Creek
- Blackberry Woods
- Bristol Bay
- Cornerstone Briarwood
- Country Hills
- Grande Reserve
- Heartland Circle
- Windett Ridge



Enumerators will be knocking on doors this summer. All workers will have a U.S. Census Bureau badge. The enumerator will ask residents five questions for each person living in the household, the interview should take about 10 minutes.

Your answers are private. Every Census Bureau worker takes an oath to protect your answers. The Census Bureau never releases information that identifies you or your household.
