Dear Resident,

With the first utility bill of the new fiscal year, I would like to share some good news with you. The cost for garbage service has decreased from last year, the City's garbage services have expanded to include e-waste and food scraps, water rates will remain unchanged from last year, and the City's street program will expand into new neighborhoods.

First, the City went out to bid for garbage services in late 2016, and was able to receive favorable pricing from multiple companies. The low bidder was Advanced Disposal, who committed to provide garbage service to all residents for \$16.50 per household per month – a decrease of \$2.75 per household, per month. Included within this new garbage service is a discount for anyone who wishes to use a 33-gallon garbage tote (\$15.95 per month) instead of the standard 65-gallon tote. Also, if you need a larger, 95-gallon tote instead, your price remains the same as a 65-gallon tote. If you want to change your tote size, please call Advanced Disposal at 630-587-8282 during normal business hours and they will set up delivery of the new tote and removal of the old tote at no charge to you.

Second, as part of the bid for garbage services, Advanced Disposal also committed to curbside, on-demand e-waste recycling and the inclusion of food waste into the City's unlimited, all-inclusive yard-waste collection program. TVs, computers, printers and other e-waste can be recycled for no charge at your curb by scheduling a pickup with Advanced Disposal. More information on e-waste and composting can also be found on the City's website at www.yorkville.il.us.

Third, the City was able to hold the line on water rates for the upcoming year. While the City is studying the long-term viability of the City's water sources, tight management of expenditures within the water department and growth in water revenues from all of the new homes being built in Yorkville meant that the water utility could keep rates the same as last year.

You'll see contractors throughout town, as soon as next week, beginning the City's annual program for paving, crack sealing, striping, water main improvements and sanitary sewer lining. This year's program will include a little over \$1,000,000 in total improvements. If you live near major roadwork, you'll receive a flyer on your door as the work approaches.


We'll be milling and paving the west end of Madison Court from W. Madison Street, Madison Street to Morgan Street, Main Street from W. Van Emmon to W. Hydraulic, Main Street from S. Bridge Street to W. Ridge Street, Washington Street from W. Morgan Street to S. Main Street, Pavillion Road to Fox Road to the City limits, E. Ridge Street from East End to Mill Street, Walsh Drive from Greenbrier to W. Barberry Circle, Spring Street from Quinsey to McHugh, and Tower Lane. There will also be patching completed along Fox Road and White Oak Way. Additionally, residents of Countryside will see major resurfacing roadway work occurring in their subdivision that will finish the watermain and street project that began last year. Finally, Route 34 between Route 47 and Orchard Rd will be under construction for the next couple years as the State expands Route 34 to four lanes.
