

The Fox River, Kendall County Courthouse building, and existing architectural style found throughout the downtown area were used for inspiration. Utilizing familiar brick and limestone materials, consistent with existing architecture, each concept reflects the character of Yorkville.

The proposed concepts utilize horizontal layers, archway elements, and detailed cornices to reflect the Italianate architecture so prevalent in the downtown area. The distinct image of the courthouse cupola also inspires the design for the Downtown Major Gateway and Informational kiosk, establishing a visual connection between the elements and creating a consistent identity for Downtown Yorkville.






