Dear Resident,

We would like you to give us some feedback on City services. This is our fourth comprehensive survey of all City services. Your input is something we truly value as your responses are used to recruit new businesses, improve service delivery and align City Council actions with community needs.

One primary example in which we have applied your feedback to make changes is the first year we completed the survey. That year the two most frequent requests were to invest more in the City's road infrastructure and to reduce property taxes. Since then, we have created the City's Road to Better Roads program which allocates over \$1 million per year to pavement, water, and sewer rehabilitation in the City, and we created a program to reduce property taxes through 2017.


The next few years in Yorkville will require big decisions on new and in-fill development, downtown revitalization and capital projects. This is your best opportunity to have your voice heard on all of our City services.

City Services Survey Background

The City Council would like to know what <u>you</u> think about City services and has commissioned a web survey to gather your opinions. We anticipate collecting survey responses throughout the month of January and publicizing the results of the survey in the Spring 2018.

How do I take the survey?

On any device that can navigate the internet, go to this website address: https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/yorkvillesurvey2017

The first question of the survey asks for a 10-digit numerical password. This password is located just above the message center on the front of your utility bill. After you enter the password, the survey will begin.

What can I do if I don't have access to the internet?

Please call City Hall at 630-553-4350 and set up an appointment to take the survey over the phone.

Can I take the survey more than once?

If another member of your household would like to take the survey, please call City Hall at 630-553-4350. For each additional person in your household that would like to take the survey, we will give you a password, provided you verify your utility billing address.

What kind of questions are in the survey?

The survey generally contains questions about each of the City's services and your level of satisfaction with how each service is provided. There are also open-ended questions about which types of businesses you would like to see come to Yorkville and demographic questions for our research purposes.

How will the survey responses be used?

The City Council and staff will use the survey responses to gain a better understanding of your view of the services we currently provide, with the goal to improve service delivery. The responses will also be used to set City Council priorities in the future.

Are my survey responses confidential?

Your responses will be kept confidential by our survey review team, unless you tell us otherwise within the survey. Our survey review team will consist of the same staff members that have access to our utility billing database, who are already entrusted and required to keep your utility account details private.
