**MOTION**

IT IS HEREBY moved that the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners of the City of Yorkville, Illinois, amend its current rules and regulations by adding a SECTION 12 entitled "Second List" to Chapter III to read as follows:

**" SECTION 14 – SECOND LIST**

As provided for within 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-14 of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Act, the commission may, at its discretion, prepare and keep a "Second List" of applicants all of whom have successfully completed their basic law enforcement training and have been so certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board and who, at the time of application, been employed as a full-time sworn law enforcement officer, for a minimum of 24 months, of a regular police department in any Illinois municipal, county, university, or State law enforcement agency. Applicants, for a position on a "Secondary List" shall be required to successfully pass an oral interview examination. The examination shall be based upon a scale of 1 to 100, and the passing point, if any, to be set by the vendor providing said examination or the commission and announced by the commission prior to the conduct of the examination. Notice of the examination will be provided as set forth in Section 2 of this Chapter. An applicant's position upon a "Secondary List" shall be based upon the applicant's final oral interview test score plus an award of preference points as noted above in Section 4 of this Chapter. At the time a vacancy is declared for an original appointment to a police officer's position, the commission shall have the option to fill said vacancy from its Original Eligibility List or from the Secondary List. Prior to an offer of conditional appointment applicants shall be required to undergo a polygraph examination and thorough background check as set forth in these rules. If successful, the commission shall make a conditional offer of employment subject to successful completion of an in-depth psychological examination and a thorough medical examination as provided for within these rules. Applicants appointed from a Secondary List shall serve on a probationary basis as set forth in Section 12, B above."
